Adapting and Delivering a Network at the Speed of Relevance to Enable JADC2

Key leaders from across the Army tactical network community will be joined by a representative from the U.S. Air Force (USAF) to discuss how the Army is modernizing its tactical network and how we are collaborating with sister services in support of Combined Joint All Domain Command and Control (CJADC2). N-CFT and USAF will each highlight specific areas of collaboration between the services. For example, during the recent JADC2 21-1 assessment, and between the Army's Orion Forge and the Air Force's Platform One & ABMS on DevSecOps and applications that optimize sensor to shooter and joint firing capabilities in support of Project Convergence 21. USAF will deliver an update on their network modernization and experimentation efforts. N-CFT will also provide an initial update on Capability Set 25 development and planned experiments in FY21. PEO will discuss holistically how the Army's unified network capability set modernization effort is fielding and developing technologies to enable CJADC2. DEVCOM C5ISR Center will highlight early technology integration efforts to support Project Convergence and sensor-to-shooter network demonstration and experimentation. The panel will conclude with discussion on how industry is and can be involved in the process, and what they are most excited about in network advancements and game changing technologies.
