Mr. David May is currently the Senior Advisor, U.S. Army Cyber Center of Excellence, TRADOC, and Fort Eisenhower, GA. He is responsible for providing authoritative technical advice and recommendations to senior officials regarding Army policy, doctrine, and Cyber/Electromagnetic Warfare/Signal programs to include planning, resourcing and execution of cyberspace and other multi-discipline support operations. Mr. May retired from the Army in 2016 as an Army Intelligence Colonel after serving 26 years of active Service.

CPT David Collins is a 2013 Graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point, NY, where he studied information Technology. He is also a 2023 graduate of the University of Georgia, where he studied Business Analytics. He initially served two years as a field artillery officer before transitioning to the Cyber Corps. He has held duty positions of Company Commander, Combat Support Team Lead, Combat Mission Team Operations Officer, Training and Academic Counselor, and Assistant S3. He is currently assigned as the G3/5 FUOPS and Plans Chief, U.S. Army Cyber Center of Excellence, Fort Eisenhower, GA.

1LT Sean Moriarity is a Cyber Capabilities Developer with Army Cyber's Technical Warfare Center. He graduated from the United States Military Academy in 2020 with a degree in Computer Science. Sean is the author of two books: Machine Learning in Elixir and Genetic Algorithms in Elixir. 1LT Moriarity is the lead developer for Cyber CoPilot.
