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



Information Advantage Overview







Information Forces in Theater





UNCLASSIFIED

- Information Forces are at every echelon
- > TIAD focused on executing information activates as a PERSISTENT STARE nested in the ASCC Campaign Plan
- > IA Capabilities will consolidate/standardize Program and non-Program of Record materiel solutions across the Army



New Doctrine (ADP 3-13 (Information))



Multidomain operations are the combined arms employment of joint and Army capabilities to create and exploit relative advantages that achieve objectives, defeat enemy forces, and consolidate gains on behalf of joint force commanders.





Multidomain Operations



An information advantage is a condition when a force holds the initiative in terms of situational understanding, decision making, and relevant actor behavior

Note: Each information activity consist of multiple sub-tasks.




- ADP 3-13 is a new publication that represents an evolution in how Army forces think about military uses of data and information in operations and at home station.
- Describes how Army forces, as part of a joint and multinational team, employ
 a combined arms approach to gain and exploit information advantages in
 pursuit of objectives.
- Provides fundamentals and principles of how Army forces integrate data and information as part of multidomain operations.
- Describes how Army forces directly contribute to joint operations in the information environment.
- Incorporates ideas from JP 3-04 and MCDP 8.
- Applies to all Army forces, across branches, warfighting functions, and echelons - during competition, crisis, and conflict.

Establishing unity of command while optimizing unity of effort with theater information forces




Theater Information Advantage Detachment Structure




Leverage CFT approach to leverage tech/data, disseminate messages, deny relevant actors access to information, & interact w/target audiences




IA Capability Development





ID IS-ICD prioritizes & characterize solutions across like capabilities; focuses on convergence of capabilities; ability to acquire existing solutions of IA (w/funding); potential for other organizations to leverage

- > Prototyping currently ongoing at Theater Armies
- > Standardizing materiel development across the Army
- > Developing requirements and fielding to information forces at a rapid pace




Information Dimension IS ICD establishes overarching requirement for technologies (software/supporting hardware) enabling info advantage activities

We Operate in the Physical Dimension, Influence through the Information Dimension, and we Achieve Victory in the Human Dimension!







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


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
