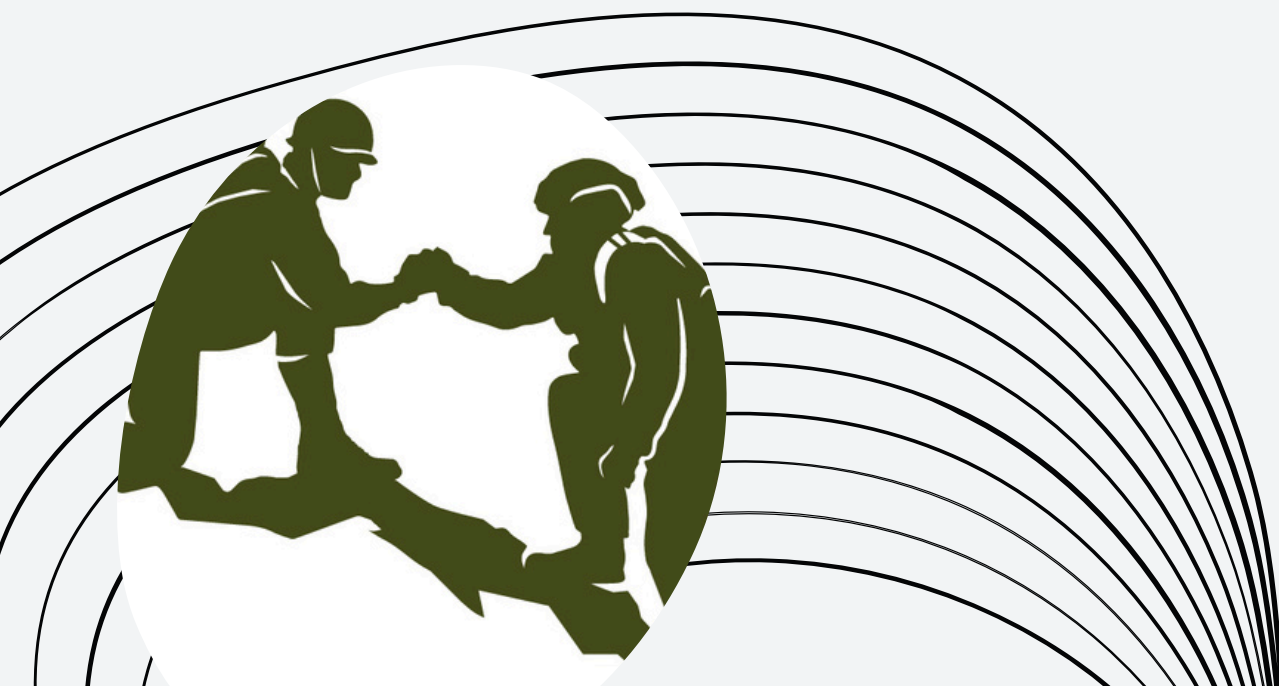
Free Parking and shuttle bus from lot.

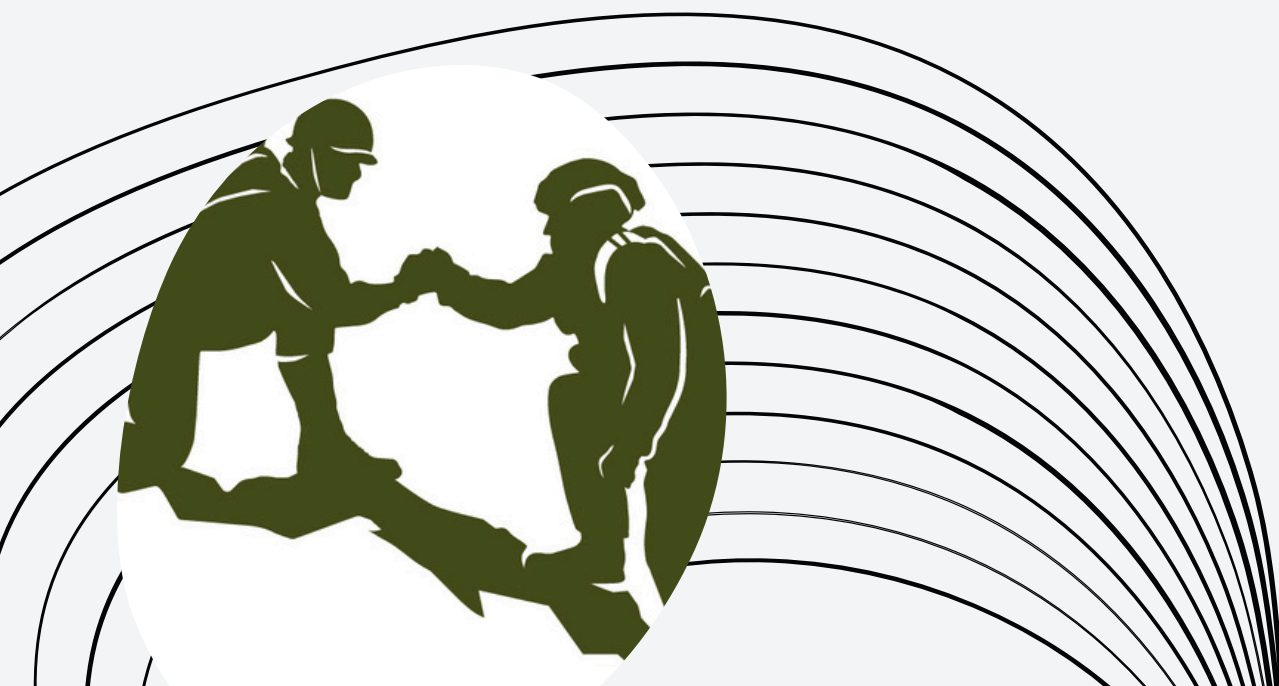

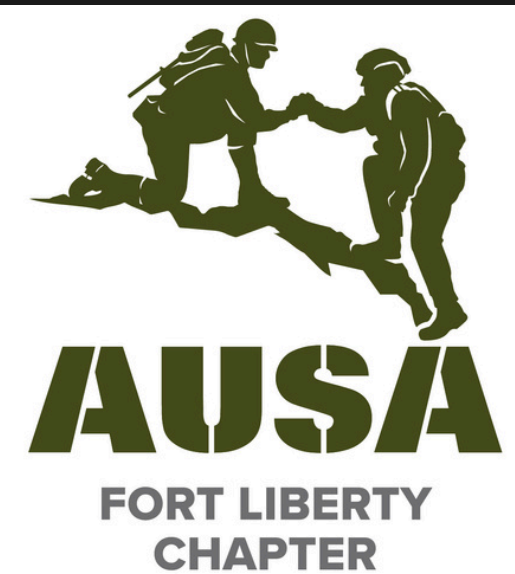
